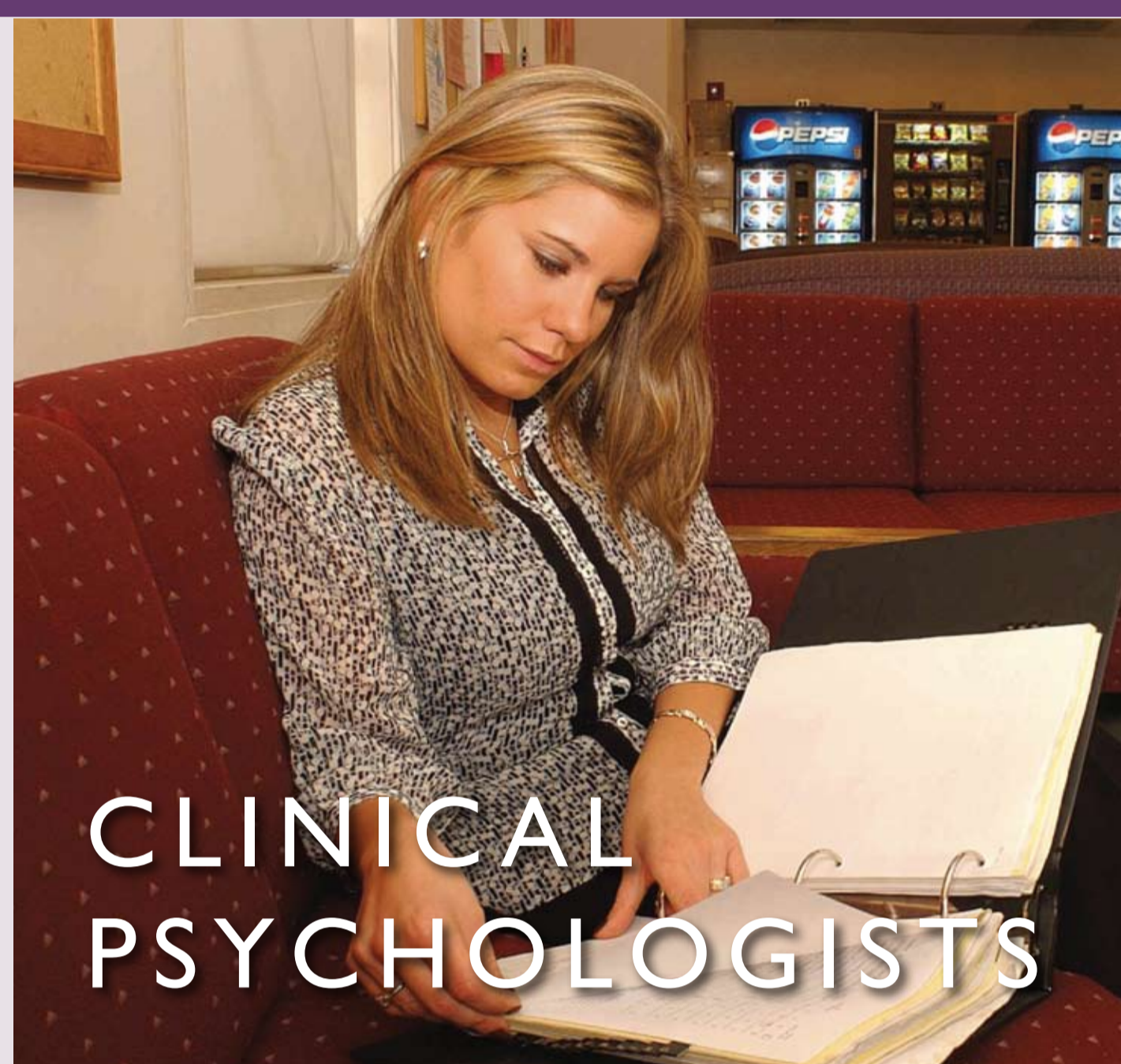

HELPING PATIENTS FIGHT CANCER WITH DIGNITY

The NELUNE Foundation aims to provide psychological and practical support, assistance and care for public hospital and underprivileged cancer patients in the community - 'Helping Patients Fight Cancer With Dignity'.

The NELUNE Foundation is a not-for-profit charity that supports children, adolescents, adults and their families to cope with the impact of cancer by providing emotional support, care and post-operative medical aids that are not covered by government or private funding.

All funds raised are donated in full to assist with the funding of a number of ongoing, long-term projects. Please help us continue this work.



The Foundation funds six full-time Clinical Psychologists in NSW public hospitals including St Vincent's Public Hospital Darlinghurst, Macarthur Cancer Therapy Centre Campbelltown, Sutherland Hospital Caringbah, St George Public Hospital Kogarah, Young Adult Cancer Patient Services Unit at Prince of Wales Public Hospital Randwick and public hospitals in the Greater Western Area Health Service which include Orange Base Hospital and Bathurst Public Hospital.

\$480,000
is required to maintain this current service each year



The Foundation funds five full-time Cancer Care Nurses specialising in all cancers including breast care, neuro-oncology care and adolescent cancer.

\$240,000
is required to maintain this service each year



The Foundation has purchased three Patient Transport Vehicles and employs two full-time Patient Transport Drivers to transport patients for treatment at NSW public hospitals including St Vincent's Public Hospital Darlinghurst, St George Public Hospital Kogarah, Sutherland Hospital Caringbah and Prince of Wales Public Hospital Randwick.

\$95,000
is required to maintain the drivers for the current service each year



The Foundation funds medication not covered by the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme.

\$50,000
is required to maintain the current demand this year



The Foundation funds dietary supplements, medical aids and cancer support aids for financially disadvantaged patients.

\$10,000
is required to maintain the drivers for the current service each year
